North America: an epic year

Susan Storey, Park World's North American editor, reports on the region's recent successes and exciting plans for the year ahead.

When referring to the attractions industry in North America, leaders and insiders have often used words like, "mature" and "established." With a healthy mix of independent regional parks, amusement park operators that own multiple locations and long-standing destination parks, industry followers have tended to look at North America as the place for great new rides and attractions, and elsewhere around the world for new parks. 2025 is turning that

long-held belief on its head as the region will see the grand opening of not one, not two, but several new parks from major brands and featuring globally recognized intellectual properties (IP's).

It's Going to be Epic.

The highly anticipated theme park, Universal Epic Universe has captured attention since the earliest hints that Universal Parks and Destinations would be adding a fourth gate to its Central Florida

operations. Heralded as a multi-billion-dollar destination the park will officially open its gates on May 22, 2025.

The new park will feature five immensely themed worlds – incredible lands that will put guests in fantastical places and spaces that have never been seen in a theme park setting. Featuring more than 50 incredible experiences that include everything from groundbreaking attractions and breathtaking entertainment to unique dining and shopping, Epic Universe will not just

raise the bar for the next generation of theme parks – it will create an entirely new way that parks are created, developed, and presented. The five themed worlds: Celestial Park, The Wizarding World of Harry Potter – Ministry of Magic, SUPER NINTENDO WORLD, How to Train Your Dragon – Isle of Berk and Dark Universe will present established and beloved IP's in entirely new ways.

Through an incredibly orchestrated and thorough marketing campaign, Universal has given guests a steady flow of updates about the park, uniquely building excitement and anticipation equally.

One of the most anticipated worlds in Epic Universe will be Dark Universe. The create the space, Universal has leaned into its roots and is classic collection of monsters and creatures that go bump in the night.



Dark Universe will full envelope guests as they embark on monstrous adventures spread across attractions, shops, restaurants and more. Created in partnership with Universal Pictures, Dark Universe blends the

iconic stories of unearthly legends like Dracula with an all-new generation of monsters and characters.

The signature attraction of Dark Universe will be Monsters Unchained: The Frankenstein Experiment – Universal Orlando's most terrifying attraction ever. The state-of-the-art dark ride will take guests deep into the catacombs of Frankenstein Manor where they will see Dr. Victoria Frankenstein at work in her laboratory. When her experiments go awry guests are immediately thrust into an incredible and intense ride that includes 14 first-of-their-kind technologically advanced life-life monsters. As guests travel through the darkness they will try to evade The Wolf Man, The Mummy, The Creature from the Black Lagoon, the Brides of Dracula and more. To kick off the scary adventure, guests be greeted with a Frankenstein's Monster that stands nine feet tall and weighs over 800 pounds (36 kilograms). Not to be judged by sheer size alone, guests will be amazed when he walks during the ride preshow. 3

Other attractions and activities in Dark Universe include Curse of the Werewolf, a spinning family coaster inspired by "The Wolf Man," the Darkmoor Monster Makeup Experience, the Meet the Monsters eerie meet and greets with the town residents included Victoria Frankenstein's servant, Ygor, The Invisible Man, an eccentric monster hunter, and more.

Beyond the shadows, Epic Universe's other lands will feature themed and experiences that full transport guests. For example, the larger-than-life Isle of Berk – based on the popular "How to Train Your Dragon" films will invite guests to soar with dragons. In delightful contrast to Dark Universe, Isle of Berk will have with the humour and heart of the animated movies

as it celebrates in a breathtaking environment. Four attractions, one live show, and several character and dragon meet-and-greet experiences will delight everyone in the family. Family thrill coaster, Hiccup's Wing Gliders, will launch riders into the sky at speeds up to 45 miles per hour (72 kilometres per hour). The coaster will soar around the perimeter of Berk and through the lagoon.

The themed entertainment design and mastery will continue in each of park's three other immersive world, almost creating separate mini parks with their own personality and experiences.

Located 2.5 miles southeast of Universal Orlando Resort, Epic Universe will also

feature its own 500-room resort, the Universal Grand Helios Hotel. Select ticket options for Epic Universe went on sale in November 2024 with minimum three-day visit ticket packages starting at \$117 per day US.

Life Sized Toys to Bring Theme Park Fun

While Epic Universe will lead the pack for share of voice, focus and theme park visitation in 2025, it will share the title of "New Park" with several other destinations.

Drawing inspiration from favourite toys and games, the first Mattel Adventure Park will debut just outside of Phoenix, Arizona. Creating incredible rides and interactive

experiences with the Mattel Toy company's most beloved brands, the immersive theme park will feature indoor and outdoor spaces. Barbie, Hot Wheels, Thomas the Tank Engine and Masters of the Universe will headline the park's marquee attractions.

Featuring attractions that have queues indoors, exciting rides and attractions travel outside, providing seamless experiences that can be experienced year-round in Arizona's arid climate. The Hot Wheels Bone Shaker: The Ultimate Ride roller coaster will feature 1500 feet (457 metres) of linear Hot Wheel roller coaster track that take riders 84 feet (25 metres) in the air. The coaster path includes a double helix that completes two full 306 degree turns

during the ride. A second roller coaster, the Hot Wheels Twin Mill Racer will zoom guests along 2,503 feet (763 metres) of track after it launches from zero to 50 miles per hour (80 kilometres per hour) in under 3 seconds.

While completion of the park has had several delays – it was originally supposed to open in 2024 – the moving target has not slower plans for additional parks in the United States. A second park is under construction in Bonner Springs, Kansas. City. In late 2024, President of Epic Resort Destinations and Mattel Adventure Park Mark Cornell announced plans to open an additional four theme parks across the country in the next ten years.

Having travelled across the pond first to Central Florida, Peppa Pig, the beloved animated piggy and her family will debut a second theme park location in the United States, this time in the heart of Texas. Merlin Entertainments announced Peppa Pig

Theme Park Dallas-Fort Worth the park will open in March. Similar in size and scope to its sister park in Lakeland, Florida, Peppa Pig Theme Park will bring the sweet world of Peppa to life for young children and their families. Signature attractions include the Zamperla-built Daddy Pig's Roller Coaster; Grampy Rabbit's Dinosaur Adventure; the wheelchair accessible Peppa Pig's Balloon Ride, Mr. Bull's High Striker and Grandad Dog's Pirate Boat Ride.

Six Flags North American Additions

Flags Entertainment Corporation, the largest amusement park operator in North America, announced it will invest more than \$1 billion to enhance its 42 parks in 2025 and 2026. Headliners in 2025 include:

Illinois: With Wrath of Rakshasa at Six Flags Great America, the Bolliger & Mabillard creation is set to break multiple world records. Complete with a beyond-

vertical, 171-foot drop, the steepest of any dive coaster in the world, Wrath of Rakshasa begins with an initial 96-degree drop before reaching speeds up to 67 miles per hour (108 kilometres per hour). The ride's path also includes five inversions, the record for any dive coaster in the world.

North Carolina: Already a guest family favourite, Camp Snoopy at Carowinds is growing this year with two new family-friendly attractions. A new launch roller coaster and an interactive raft ride will enhance the area. Snoopy's Racing Railway take guests along with Snoopy as he races to deliver root beer and pizza to Camp Snoopy's Mess Hall. The family-friendly steel launch coaster will accelerate from 0 to 31 miles per hour (50 kilometres per hour) in seconds, providing an exhilarating adventure that will take guests around the course twice. Charlie Brown's River Raft Blast is an interactive fun adventure that features on-board and

onshore water cannons and encourages engaging water play between riders as they float along the river channel.

Ontario, Canada: With AlpenFury, Canada's Wonderland will introduce a first of its kind coaster experience. The latest from Premier Rides, AlpenFury will be the

tallest, fastest and longest launch coaster in Canada. Complete with an original storyline that celebrates when fire and ice collide inside the iconic Wonder Mountain, the coaster will blast riders 164 feet (50 metres) vertical through the summit and up into the sky. Riders will experience one

of the wildest coaster rides ever created, complete with nine inversions – the most for any launch coaster in North America – at 71 miles per hour (114 kilometres per hour) along 3,281 feet (1,000 metres) of track.

Massachusetts: Six Flags New England will debut Quantum Accelerator, an LSM propulsion, multi-launch roller coaster. Thrilling guests with 11 moments of airtime the coasters cars are futuristic-style motor bikes. Reaching a top speed of 45 miles per hour (72 kilometres per hour) this new ride will appeal to guests of all ages and die-hard coaster fans alike.

Virginia: Central Virginia's beloved amusement park, Kings Dominion will celebrate its 50th anniversary with an exhilarating gift to its guests – Rapterra. Standing at 145 feet (41 metres) tall and stretching 3,086 feet (940 metres) long, the new attraction will be the world's tallest and longest launched wing coaster.

Water Park Enhancements and Splashing Fun

And while new coasters will rule the Six Flags skies in 2025, new water play will delight guests at several of the company's most popular water parks. In Ohio, Kings Island's Soak City Water Park will welcome RiverRacers, the first and only dual-racing water coaster in Ohio. The attraction will send thrill seekers down a three-story first drop, and then propel them uphill through a mirrored racecourse of enclosed and open tubes and 180-degree high-bank turns before reaching a gravity-defying final straightaway drop to the pool below. Younger guests will also delight at seven new kiddie water slides and a kids splash lagoon "swimmin' hole" and play area at Splash River Junction.

On the west coast, Hurricane Harbor Los Angeles will undergo a major transformation for its 30th anniversary

season. A comprehensive upgrade to the entire park includes expanded shaded areas, seating, cabanas, and a wider range of amenities to boost comfort and convenience. The California park's revitalization will also include colourful slide and structure refurbishments, additional landscaping and upgraded food and beverage options.

Finally, Hurricane Harbor in Arlington, Texas, will unveil its largest expansion ever. A massive 58,000-square-foot (5,300 square-metre) multi-level interactive kids play structure with 110 water features, seven water slides and a 1,000-gallon (3800 litres) Texas-sized tipping water bucket will be added to the park. A second seven-water-slide complex will include a mini-tornado water slide and mini wave slide, perfect for the park's youngest visitors to take their first water slide experiences with

small slides and safe, soft mat landing areas. In addition, a new self-play Splash Pad featuring two dozen water features; and new family cabanas, oversized umbrellas, junior-sized lounge furniture and refurbished restrooms will complete the transformation for the incredible water-themed fun under the Texan sun.

Regional Park Additions

Nestled in the beautiful Smoky Mountains, the beloved Dollywood Park is readying for its 40th anniversary. Known for its seasonal festivals and one of the only parks that features live performers across all its park shows, Dollywood is returning to its roots and tradition in 2025 with the addition of new entertainment and interactive offerings. Each day will begin with new opening ceremony when the park kicks off its operating year in March. A new drone and

fireworks show will honour the 40th anniversary during Dollywood's Smoky Mountain Summer Celebration and the Imagination Playhouse will feature a rotation of plays based on books from Dolly's Imagination Library. Celebrating the park's founder and namesake, "Heartsong: The Movie" will be remastered and moved to the Dreamsong Theatre as part of The Dolly Parton Experience.

The sweetest park in the industry will take guests to new heights when Hersheypark in Pennsylvania debuts Twizzlers Twisted Gravity. Set to open in the summer, Twizzlers Twisted Gravity will be a high-thrill pendulum attraction. Lasting for one-minute and 10-second, the experience begins as riders ascend 137 adrenaline-pumping feet (42 metres) and then seemingly defies gravity as it swings at speeds reaching 68 miles per hour (109 kilometres per hour). Manufactured by S&S Worldwide, the all-new Twizzlers candy-inspired adventure will seat guests in one of four branded zones across two gondolas: Twizzlers Strawberry, Cherry, Hershey's Chocolate and Black Licorice flavours.

SeaWorld Orlando in Florida will debut the AIRIFIC Flying Theatre this spring. Looking to MACK Rides the all-new attraction will have a 39" inch (.9 metre) height requirement. The experience will perfectly blend of MACK's engineering mastery and expertise with SeaWorld's commitment to conservation and education. Still dubbed the "Arctic Flying Theatre" the new attraction will have a run time of four and a half minutes as it transports guests to the Arctic. Riders will soar over the icy wonderland for glimpses of sea creatures including whales, orcas, and walrus. At press time, SeaWorld Orlando has confirmed the attraction but remained quiet about its official name and full storyline.

Latin American perspectives

Maria Izabel Reigada reports from Latin America as Brazil and Mexico in particular consolidate themselves as destinations for theme parks and attractions.

Having recovered pre-pandemic numbers, the theme parks and tourist attractions sector in Latin America received new developments and investments in at least two of its main markets in 2024: Mexico and Brazil. In Mexico, Grupo Vidanta presented the project for Vidanta World's BON Luxury Theme Park, a luxury theme park set to open in 2026 following an investment of US\$1.3 billion.

Located in Nuevo Vallarta on the west coast of Mexico, the theme park will feature at least 23 attractions, 25 restaurants, 16 shops and kiosks, and high-end hotels, including the already-opened Vidanta World's BON Park Hotel. Vidanta Group's partners in the project include Cirque du Soleil and some of the world's leading manufacturers of amusement park attractions, such as Intamin

and Vekoma Rides. "Our theme park represents a monumental leap forward in the world of entertainment, redefining what a theme park can be as the premier luxury destination for all generations around the world," says Vidanta Group Executive Vice President, Iván Chávez.

Although the luxury theme park is scheduled to open in 2026, Ludo - a dinner show with an aquatic theme by Cirque du Soleil - is expected to be unveiled by November of this year. The idea is to innovate in live entertainment through a fusion of art, technology and storytelling. "Our collaboration with the industry's leading visionaries ensures that Vidanta World's BON will not only captivate guests of all ages but will also establish itself as one of the most iconic and transformative destinations in the world," believes Chávez.

In Brazil, 2024 began with an important announcement for the theme park market: the purchase of the traditional Playcenter Group, one of the pioneers of the sector in the country, by the largest Brazilian franchise chain, Cacau Show, a food sector group with more than 4,200 units, which has shown an 'appetite' for the theme park sector. After its arrival in the tourism sector with the acquisition of two hotels, the Cacau Show Group acquired the Playcenter Group and, last December, announced the construction of Cacau Park, a new theme park with an investment of US\$330.5 million, scheduled to open in 2027.

With cocoa production and chocolate as its themes, Cacau Park will occupy one million square meters of land measuring seven million square meters in Itu, 120 kilometers from São Paulo, Brazil's largest

city. "We want to do something so relevant that consumers will want to come and see us," said the president of Cacau Show, Alexandre Costa, when announcing the start of construction. "We want consumers who leave Brazil to seek experiences abroad and also those who don't have that opportunity. We want to be accessible; good taste doesn't cost anything." There are plans for 50 attractions, 35 of which are international, provided by enterprises like Vekoma, whose vice president of Sales and Marketing, Ricardo Etges, participated in the announcement of the start of construction.

"I believe that the Cacau Park project is a milestone for the park segment in Brazil. It is without a doubt the most ambitious project in history in the country, due to its magnitude, commitment, quality and all the work done to develop this project," says Ricardo Etges. "As a Brazilian who works in this global industry, I never imagined that I would work on a project of this magnitude and with such repercussions in Brazil. I am very happy, personally, and also as Vekoma, to participate in a project with a significant number of our attractions and to be doing business in Brazil again."

Brazil

In the Brazilian Northeast, another investment with a major impact on the sector is the Cabo Branco Tourist Complex, in the state of Paraíba. The tourist complex has an area of 654 hectares and is expected to integrate resorts, the first indoor water park in the Northeast, a Ferris wheel and a theme park, with a roller coaster and a drop tower, among other attractions announced in December by WAM Experience, a group that owns hotels throughout Brazil. In addition, the Acquaí Park, an outdoor water park, is also being built, with its first phase expected to open in the first half of this year.

In São Paulo, two new theme parks are also scheduled to open in the coming months: Sítio do Picapau Amarelo, which is themed around the most famous characters in Brazilian children's literature,

by author Monteiro Lobato; and Vila dos Smurfs Park. With attractions for children aged 2 to 14, Vila dos Smurfs will be the fourth Smurfs Park in the world, after the ventures in Shanghai, China, Dubai, in the United Arab Emirates, and Moscow, Russia.

With investments estimated at US\$2.5 billion in the parks and attractions sector in the coming years, according to the 2nd edition of "Parks, Tourist Attractions and Entertainment in Brazil – Sector Panorama", the market is expected to grow significantly in the country. Conducted by Brazil's two main park and attraction associations – Sindepat (Integrated System of Parks and Tourist Attractions) and Adibra (Brazilian Association of Parks and Attractions) – the study indicates a market of 128 million annual visitors and revenue of US\$1.35 billion in 2023. In May, during the Sindepat Summit, the main event for the sector in Brazil, the 2024 figures will be presented with the launch of the 3rd Sector Panorama. In the current edition, the outlook was for an 11% increase in visitation last year, compared to 2023.

The investment amount includes projects that were opened throughout 2024, such as Arvorar (Ceará), which redefines the experience within parks, combining environmental education, preservation and fun; and Multiparque, the first water park in

Balneário Camboriú (SC), among many others. "In recent years, we have seen a large number of parks and tourist attractions opening. In December 2019, for example, Rio de Janeiro opened the first international-style Ferris wheel in Brazil, which is an attraction in itself", says the Executive President of Sindepat, Carolina Negri. "Today, we already have ferris wheels in Foz do Iguaçu, São Paulo, Balneário Camboriú, Canela and Maceió. All of this despite the years of pandemic", she points out.

In addition to tourist attractions, parks with dinosaur themes have also proliferated in Brazil in recent years, with highlights including Terra dos Dinos, in Rio de Janeiro, Aventura Jurassic, in Santa Catarina, and Alchymist Prehistoric Park, in Ceará. "We also saw the opening of theme parks with specific themes in 2024, such as NBA Park, the first NBA theme park in the world, which opened in southern Brazil in 2023; Mundo Criamigos, a park focused on the playful universe of plush toys, which opened last year; and Spitz Pomer, dedicated to German culture, which also opened in 2024," highlights the Executive President of Sindepat, also emphasizing the water parks under construction. "We have seen a large number of water park projects under development alongside hotel projects," she adds.



Rankings and expansion

The Theme Entertainment Association (TEA/AECOM), which created the Theme Index Report, annually publishes a ranking of the most visited parks in the world, divided into theme and water parks, as well as museums. Although Latin American theme parks achieve much more modest numbers than their peers in the United States, Europe and Asia, the same is not true when analyzing water parks. Last year's Theme Index Report, with data from 2023, places a Brazilian water park in the lead among the most visited worldwide. While Therma's dos Laranjais received 1,954,000 visitors, the most visited water park in North America, Typhoon Lagoon Disney World received 1,898,000 and the highest-ranked European park, Therme Erding, in Germany, was visited by 1,860,000 people.

The study highlights that water park growth in Latin America is strong, with five parks surpassing one million visitors per year. "The Latin American water park

market has been steady and strong, marking its third year of double-digit growth and far exceeding pre-pandemic records," notes the Theme Index.

Among the reasons cited for the success of water parks in some destinations, such as Brazil, which has six of the ten most visited water parks in Latin America, is the development of new products associated with accommodation, with diversified real estate portfolios, such as fractional products (timeshare). The sectoral overview carried out by Sindepat and Adibra on the Brazilian market also highlights that water parks are emerging as a robust trend also due to the favorable climate. The study indicates that approximately 41% of the supply of theme and water parks are linked to hotel, multi-ownership or timeshare ventures, classified as tourism-real estate projects.

Brazil is the address also of the most visited theme park in Latin America, according to the latest edition of the Theme Index Report, which recorded

2,792,000 visitors in the year. The second and third places are held by the Mexican Six Flags, with 2,021,000, and Xcaret, with 1,637,000 visitors. The Brazilian Hopi Hari appears in fourth place, with 1,039,000, followed by Mundo Aventura, from Colombia, with 1,015,000. The top ten of the most visited Latin American theme parks also includes the Chilean Fantasilandia; the Mundo Petapa, from Guatemala; the Parque Temático Nacional del Café, from Colombia; the Argentine Parque de la Costa; and the El Salitre Magico, from Colombia. Together, they received 12.5 million visitors in 2023, an increase of 20% compared to the previous year.

Colombia

With three of the most visited parks in Latin America, Colombia has seen recent investments in two of them. At the end of last year, Parque del Café opened Colombia's first inverted roller coaster, Aviv. Made by Gerstlauer, the attraction is an Infinity Coaster model and is 26 meters high with a 355-meter track, reaching speeds of 72 km/h. With an investment of approximately US\$7 million, Aviv was considered a milestone in the history of the enterprise.

"We are very proud to be the first in Colombia to offer an inverted roller coaster," said the park's general manager, Pedro Salazar Hoyos. "It is a milestone in the park's history, which reaffirms its commitment to innovation and the creation of experiences that not only highlight the beauty of our region but also offer moments of fun and excitement for our visitors, in addition to development for our region and country," he said during the inauguration.

The previous year, another Colombian park also ranked among the most visited by TEA/EACOM, El Salitre Magico, opened Drakko, a roller coaster manufactured by Premier Rides. At 47 meters high and with a 263-meter track, the ride can reach speeds of up to 100 km/h. The investment was approximately US\$12 million.

Regional development

Despite the challenges by many Latin American economies, such as recession and inflation, the parks and tourist attractions sector develop at different speeds in the region. Although faster in markets such as Brazil, Mexico and Colombia, for example, the sector is still in its infancy in other countries. Despite these regional differences, a study by IAAPA Latin America, released in April of last year, shows that the parks and tourist attractions sector have an economic impact of US\$30.1 billion in the 27 countries of the region. The study includes theme and water parks, as well as attractions such as museums, cultural attractions, zoos and aquariums.

"The study is a significant milestone in our understanding of the economic impact of the attractions industry in Latin America and the Caribbean," explains Paulia Reyes, Vice President and Executive Director of IAAPA Latin America, the Global Association for Attractions Industry. Among the data collected by the study is the total of 828,400 jobs supported by parks and



attractions, 528 thousand of which are direct. In addition, companies in the sector contributed more than US\$2.8 billion in tax payments during the year.

The data revealed in the IAAPA study and the Sector Panorama of Parks and Attractions in Brazil, by Adibra and Sindepat, prove that the parks and tourist attractions industry contribute significantly to the development of the destinations in which they are located, creating jobs and distributing income. The installation of these

enterprises, even the smaller ones, implies developing infrastructures and hiring of local labor, after these natives have been trained by the parks and attractions themselves, in search of professionals for their enterprises.

Despite political and economic issues that hinder the sector's progress in Latin American markets, such as currency devaluation in an industry where equipment is sold in dollars and legal uncertainty, a study by The Business Research Company, a market research giant, shows that the global amusement and theme park market generated US\$95.5 billion in 2024 and estimates the industry's size at US\$99.34 billion this year. In 2029, this volume will reach US\$114.77 billion, according to the study.

The sector's expansion is supported by different factors, many of which are also occurring in Latin America, such as technological innovation, increased income and the search for unique, immersive and interactive experiences, with the capacity to attract new visitors and increase the frequency of visits. The proliferation of social media also increases the visibility of parks, with visitors sharing their experiences and influencing others in their visit choices. The trends identified in the study lead us to believe in the expansion of parks and attractions in Latin American markets where this industry is already established, such as Mexico, Brazil, Colombia and Argentina.

Highlights – Innovation: Latin America: largest and faster

Some of the attractions acquired by theme parks, water parks and tourist attractions in Latin American markets are unprecedented in the region or even in the world, as are some of the attractions that will be presented in the parks under construction. Here are just some of them:

Beach Park (Ceará, Brazil) – Surreal is the name of the largest water roller coaster in the world that WhiteWater is building at Beach Park, one of the main water parks in Brazil. It is 28 meters high and 342 meters long, breaking the world record held by a water roller coaster in Chicago (USA). The experiences lasting approximately one and a half minutes will be carried out on double tubes reaching up to 42 km/h.

Cacau Park (São Paulo, Brazil) – A roller coaster developed by Vekoma that should be the fastest in Latin America, with a height of 55 meters and a speed of 120 km/h in 5 seconds; CityWalk inspired by Universal's parks, an open-air boulevard with themed shops and restaurants; two themed hotels with over a thousand rooms.

Parque del Café (Quindío, Colombia) – The country's first inverted roller coaster, the Avix, manufactured by Gerstlauer, opened in December. At 26 meters high and 355 meters long, Avix reaches speeds of 72 km/h.

Vidanta World's BON Luxury Theme Park (Nuevo Vallarta, Mexico) – Among the planned attractions are the Tecuani Beast, the only double-launch roller coaster in Latin America; Beat It; Ashara: Goddess of Fire; Sol: Speed of Light; Izari's Flight; Delia's Adventure; and Vista Wheel, among others.

2024: Strength in Europe

We examine the European market as it enjoys one of the most transformative periods ever seen, bringing excitement, innovation and adventure to a diverse audience.

With COVID-19 feeling almost like a distant half-remembered fever nightmare, 2024 saw innovation across the industry and an enthusiastic return to form for many of the European players. Europe's amusement park industry has always been characterised by a unique blend of historical and futuristic attractions, reflecting the rich cultural heritage of European countries. However, significant investments in tourism and entertainment throughout 2024 fuelled the expansion of amusement parks across the continent.

Amusement parks across Europe rank among the world's top tourist destinations, drawing millions of visitors annually. Outdoor parks capitalise on this popularity by offering diverse entertainment experiences to both domestic and international tourists. Globally, amusement parks are constantly evolving, incorporating cutting-edge technologies and attractions. In Europe, parks are embracing innovations such as virtual reality (VR), augmented reality (AR), and Internet of Things (IoT)-enabled interactive experiences to enhance visitor engagement and thrill.

Large-scale "mega parks" dominate the theme park industry by attracting the majority of guests with their state-of-the-art rides and immersive environments. However, smaller parks, often categorised as Tier 3, also play a key role in driving regional market growth. The expanding middle class, increasing urbanisation, and rising tourism spending are primary factors fuelling the overall growth of the theme park sector.

Currently, ticket sales account for around 52% of the industry's total market share, and this segment is poised for significant growth.

Parks are adopting dynamic pricing strategies, offering a wide range of ticketing options, and promoting online sales to maximise revenue. Accessibility remains a priority, with many parks providing flexible ticket packages, seasonal discounts, and digital ticketing solutions. For instance, Disney introduced discounted children's tickets at its parks last October. The shift toward online ticketing and the use of technology-driven solutions have streamlined the purchasing process, making it more convenient for visitors.

A challenging year

2024 was not, however, without its challenges. Cost of living pressures dampened in-park spending. Admissions, rides and games accounted for the majority of revenue, but amusement and theme parks often charge customers for additional entertainment once they've entered the park. With escalating inflation, parks faced higher expenses, leading to increased ticket prices. Some consumers with weakened disposable incomes tightened their purse strings and avoided high-cost purchases.

Highlights across the region

We began the year celebrating the record-breaking 12 months **Toverland** had enjoyed in the Netherlands town of Sevenum. 1,165,000 people visited Toverland in the previous 12 months, an increase of 13% for the park following an expansion that included two new large and two smaller attractions (including Intamin's 'Dragonwatch' – a 20-metre parachute tower and 'Pixarus', an interactive Sky Fly from Gerstlauer), plus extra play areas and various interactive experiences.

The UK's oldest theme park, **Blackgang Chine**, received a new attraction – **The Jolly Robin**. This new, unique swinging ship ride immersed riders into the frightening



story of a haunted ship sunk by a large whale in a storm. By entering the whale's mouth, visitors got to experience the tale from the perspective of the buried souls.

An interesting collaboration was unveiled between **Lagotronics** and the Dutch government. **The Chocolate Factory** combined state-of-the-art technology in an industrial environment designed to help visitors discover the world of food tech in a unique way. An Operator Room would offer 12 player consoles featuring levers, touchscreens, light effects and sounds effects to monitor the production process.

The opening of the **Damonen Gruft** (Demon's Crypt) a compact (380 m2) dark ride produced by **Alterface** offered guests at Heide Park Resort, northern Germany's largest theme park, an immersive plunge into a dangerous netherworld.

It was good news for one of the UK's most iconic visitor attractions - the lastminute.com **London Eye** – as Lambeth Council confirmed that it could remain on London's South bank. Councillors voted unanimously to support a recommendation from officers to discharge a condition attached to the 2003 planning permission

that required the local planning authority to decide whether the attraction could be retained beyond 2028.

Emerald Park officially opened its first fully themed and immersive land, **Tir Na nOg**, home to Europe's longest intertwining family and thrill coasters, 'Na Fianna Force' and 'The Quest'. The opening marked a substantial investment of 22 million Euros at the 6.5-acre theme park and zoo.

Momentum Leisure celebrated the Grand Opening of its third theme park in Poland, **Majaland Gdańsk**. After the successful openings of Majaland Kownaty (2018) and Majaland Warsaw (2022), the Amsterdam-based developer and operator of theme parks strengthened its position in the growth market of Central and Eastern Europe by adding Majaland Gdańsk to its portfolio.

Fairytale Farm celebrated being recognised as England's fastest-growing farm attraction in a VisitEngland survey. The attraction had already enjoyed a remarkable 130% increase in visitor numbers between 2019 and 2023 but reported a year-on-year increase of 74% over the previous 12 months. Fairytale Farm also received a Travellers' Choice award from TripAdvisor, placing it among the top 10% of attractions worldwide based on reviews and ratings for the year.

We got to see the first images from the new amusement park, **Bommelwereld** during a presentation at **Jora Vision's**

IAAPA Expo Europe booth. The new theme park, based on the beloved cartoon character Olivier B. Bommel and his comrade Tom Poes of cartoonist Marten Toonder was announced as a 9,000 square metre indoor park set in castle Bommestein.

Little Lion Entertainment announced the launch of the **PAC-MAN LIVE EXPERIENCE**, a real-life physical experience based on the iconic video game. The experience would see Little Lion Entertainment's Games Arena venues transformed into immersive, interactive mazes, with players stepping into the roles of PAC-people physically, navigating the iconic levels, collecting power pellets and fruit, all the while dodging the ever-present ghosts.

Anticipated openings for 2025

Launch Pad is a reimaged and re-themed take on the famous Blackpool Pleasure Beach Resort ride – Ice Blast. The ride includes a brand-new pressure cylinder that will change the present ride experience and shove passengers with more force than they have in recent years, in addition to the new branding and theming. Amanda Thompson OBE, CEO of Pleasure Beach Resort, said: "Earlier [in 2024] we

announced that we are focusing on constantly evolving and renewing our ride offering, and confirmed our intention to make some exciting announcements in the future. The new era of Launch Pad is only the first, and we're looking forward to everything the future holds at Pleasure Beach Resort."

Kraftverket has been announced as a new family thrill ride due to open in spring 2025 at Swedish amusement park, Liseberg. The construction of Kraftverket, which translates to "the power house," is underway in the southern section of Liseberg. This new addition is situated below one of the park's major attractions,

the Valkyria dive coaster. "Kraftverket may seem unassuming based on its size, but don't let that fool you. This will be a true family thrill ride. We are very proud to bring back this classic to Liseberg," said Andreas Andersen, CEO of Liseberg. There are long-term development plans for Liseberg, specifically for the southern part of the park. The plan for Kraftverket has been in place since the construction of Valkyria in 2016, and now the time has finally come to unleash the power. Kraftverket will be a perfect complement to the park's other attractions."

GRAND PRIX EDventure is an exciting new interactive 3D family dark ride set to open under Europa Park's Food Loop (the OG roller coaster) restaurant. Germany's largest theme park has announced that this brand-new dark ride will open for its 2025 season. GRAND PRIX EDventure will transport families into the heart of the animated family motion picture GRAND PRIX OF EUROPE – a Co-production between MACK Magic and Warner Bros. Film Productions of Germany.

The new ride will use state of the art multimedia and special effects to thrust families into the heart of the action as they



take centre stage in the pair's adrenaline fuelled story. The ride itself is set to be a MACK Rides Gameplay Theatre – the exact same type of ride set to make up Ghostly Manor at Paultons Park.

Aquila is a new indoor Family Launch Coaster from Vekoma, due to open at the Polish theme park Mandoria in 2025. Reaching speeds up to 70 km/h (43.5 mph) this 450-meter (1,476-foot) ride will do a double pass with a second launch on the fly, creating a 900-meter ride experience for the whole family. The 95-centimeter (38-inch) rider height restriction is the lowest for this Family Launch Coaster with an acceleration from 0-70 km/h in just 3 seconds!

Bulder Baan is an indoor Family Coaster due to open at the new indoor theme park, Bommelwereld, when it opens its doors to the public in 2025. With a track length of 257 meters and maximum speed of 45 km/h, this ride takes people through the mysterious mountains. Vekoma has partnered with Jora Vision and Bommelwereld to create a new indoor coaster experience that is specifically designed to offer the entire family a thrilling adventure, with a minimum height requirement of 95 centimetres, ensuring that even younger guests can join in the fun. The coaster's unique layout features extended columns, allowing visitors to walk beneath the majority of the ride and witness the action from a captivating perspective. To further enhance the experience, the curves are strategically designed to place other attractions in the centre of the park. This creates a dynamic and engaging environment as the coaster zigzags through the indoor space, offering guests multiple vantage points to enjoy the ride.

Disney Tales of Magic is a new immersive nighttime spectacular due to start at Disneyland Paris in January 2025. The



nighttime spectacular will transport visitors into the most enchanting Walt Disney Animation Studios and Pixar Animation Studios stories, delivering an emotionally moving experience. It will be presented daily in front of the Sleeping Beauty Castle in the Disneyland Park. Leveraging its unique expertise to immerse guests into a truly unique sensory journey through some of the most beloved stories from Disney Animation and Pixar, guests will experience a thrilling and emotional story as Main Street, USA seamlessly integrates into the

show's staging, blending harmoniously with the breath-taking projections on Sleeping Beauty Castle.

This complex show programming required over 17,500 hours of work, leveraging the most advanced 3D technologies. To achieve this unprecedented projection quality, Disneyland Paris teams have enlisted the expertise of London-based NorthHouse, to help bring the show's immersive visual experiences to life with a new level of artistry and innovation.

More to look out for in 2025

Wild West Coaster: Winnoland in France will open its new Kalypso Family Coaster, offering excitement for families of all ages with a maximum speed of 46km/h and a track length of 254 meters.

Terra at Conyland: This Swiss roller coaster features swinging cars navigating sharp twists and turns, appealing to a wide range of thrill-seekers.

Helios at Fantana: A custom Mack Rides Striker Coaster that will elevate the park's offerings with speed, inversions, and immersive theming.

Wier Looping at Wiener Prater: An ambitious Mack Rides big dipper coaster with a height of 101 ft and multiple inversions, including a beyond vertical drop.

Yoi at Wabby Holland: A custom duelling Raptor coaster by RMC, featuring two distinct experiences for family-friendly and intense rides.

Gers Family Coaster at Holiday Park: '100% Wolf' will feature a switch track and a vertical spike, this addition will enhance family-friendly thrills.

Speedboat at Wabby Belgium: A family coaster from Gerschlauser that will hover over the park's waterways.

Attraction Industry Update for Asia Region

For the Asia region, 2024 was a year of continued recovery from the pandemic with strong results in part of Asia and challenges in China with slow consumer spending. Chris Yoshii, Vice President, AECOM, reports.

In China

The general mood in China remains subdued with weak consumer spending and intense price competition affecting the local market. As 2023 was a big recovery year for theme parks, in terms of attendance numbers, there was hope for a recovery of profitability in 2024. However, low spending and price

sensitivity left a number of parks struggling to be profitable. Lower-cost attractions such as museums, zoos, aquariums and scenic areas are seeing strong visitation.

– Shanghai Disneyland had a great year in 2023 and expected to equal that performance in 2024. Shanghai Disneyland remains a popular destination,

and Disney is committed to investing in its long-term growth. The Zootopia land opened in December 2023 and has become one of the most popular theme lands. Shanghai Disneyland announced a new Spider-Man-themed roller coaster on August 11, 2024. This will be the park's first major Marvel attraction and is set to open in late 2025

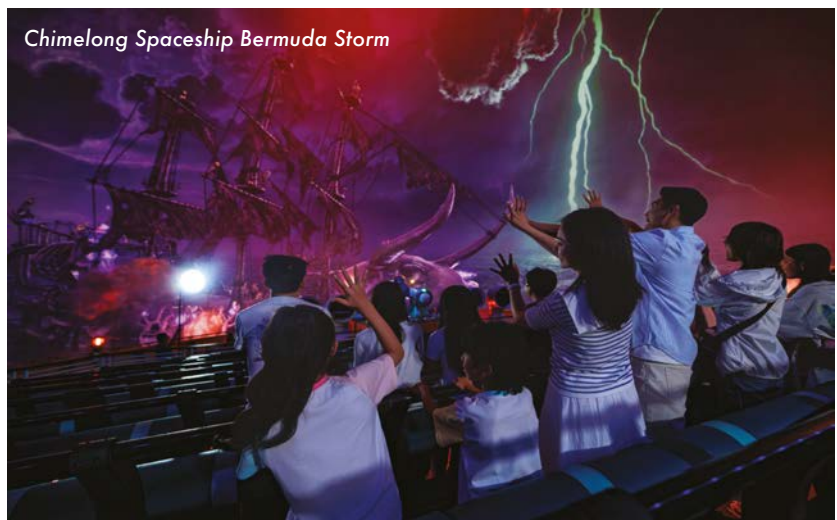
- Universal Studios Beijing had the Scares @ Universal Halloween event, which was quite popular in 2024. The event saw a significant increase in attendance compared to its debut in 2023. Universal Studios Beijing has even kept two of the Halloween attractions open for a longer operating period.
- Fantawild Group, the owner of the Boonie Bear IP, opened 9 theme parks or water parks throughout China, all opened by the end of August 2024. Almost all these projects are "asset light" meaning Fantawild is responsible for the design, implementation and operation but is not the park owner. Fantawild also opened a new themed shopping mall with a "Boonie bear" theme. The 1-million-square-foot mall has Boonie Bear sculptures throughout the mall, a Boonie Cubs FEC with amusement rides and other lifestyle, recreational tenants.
- For local industry leader, Chimelong, their THEA award winning spaceship theme attraction underwent a series of upgrades adding more indoor rides and children's play areas to attract the family market. Halloween at their Paradise Park in Guangzhou was very successful. Chimelong Ocean Kingdom in Zhuhai added a cable car attraction. Finally, Chimelong, the new destination forest theme resort and animal safari in Qinyuan, north of Guangzhou, is expected to finally open in early 2025.
- Jinma, one of the largest theme park ride manufacturers in China is entering the investment and operations area. Jinma installed rides and took over management of a new ungated amusement park in Zhongshan, near Zhuhai.

- Shanghai Legoland There are high expectations for the new Legoland under construction in Shanghai. The investment level is higher than typical Legoland parks and new rides and theme lands will be on offer. Shanghai Legoland will feature the first Monkey King area, called "Lego Monkie Kid" which is only available in China. The opening date scheduled for June 2025 and many of the rides are installed and undergoing testing.
- Indoor skiing and snow play attractions in urban locations are becoming more popular with new projects opening in Shanghai, Shenzhen and many other cities. These are smaller footprints which also incorporate shopping centers and dining complexes.
- Hong Kong Disneyland is still benefiting from their new Frozen Land which opened in 2023. Hong Kong Disneyland upgraded their evening spectacular with a drone show element.
- In 2025, the 11 Skies project which bills itself as a "game changing retailtainment destination is expect to open at the Hong

Kong International Airport. 11 Skies will have a number of new attractions including Kidzania, a soaring over Hong Kong flying theatre and a Paddington's play adventure.

Southeast Asia

- Tourism is rebounding in Southeast Asia with opening up of visa-free travel with China as well as strong intra-regional travel. The economies in Southeast Asia are strong and the young middle-class populations are seeking entertainment experiences. As the theme attraction industry in Southeast Asia benefits from international tourism, a recovering tourism market is important for industry success.
- It was a busy year for Sentosa Island, Sentosa Sensoryscape opened in March 2024, a free interactive landscape and art park that comes alive at night. Sentosa Island hosted a temporary Harry Potter Forbidden Forest experience. Harry Potter remains in Singapore at Resorts World Resort in the form of a Visions of Magic, interactive art exhibition.



- Universal Studios Singapore is expecting to open the Minion Land on February 14, 2025. Minion Land will feature the world's first-ever Minion 3D ride, themed dining, exclusive merchandise, and entertainment. It's inspired by the "Despicable Me" franchise and will take over the former Madagascar ride.
- The Mandai Resorts in Singapore (with the famous Singapore Zoo and Night Safari) is expected to open its 5th theme park experience Rainforest Wild Asia in 2025. This is expected to be a highly immersive experience of rainforest environments.
- In Vietnam, Sun Group continues to go from strength to strength upgrading and expanding their attractions, resorts and experiences. They are benefiting from a strong domestic tourism and international

tourism market. Their new show - Kiss of the Sea - designed by ECA2 in Phu Quoc won a THEA award.

Japan

- The latest addition to Universal Studios Japan in Osaka is the Donkey Kong Country area, which officially opened on December 11, 2024. This new section is part of the expanded Super Nintendo World and features the main attraction, Mine Cart Madness, a thrilling roller coaster ride inspired by the iconic mine cart levels from the Donkey Kong video games.
- Tokyo Disney continued to roll out attractions and hospitality offerings at their major Fantasy Springs expansion project at Disneysea. Frozen theme land opened to great success in 2024. Two fully themed and integrated hospitality offerings opened, including an ultra-luxury

boutique hotel and full-scale theme resort hotel. Disney is in particular benefiting from a surge in international tourism to Japan. Japan has become a top destination within the Asia region.

- Ghibli theme park successfully opened more theme zones with limited admission tickets selling out quickly. The Ghibli theme park is located within the Aichi Expo site East of Nagoya.

Korea

- In Korea, digital media art exhibitions are having strong runs, particularly in integrated reports. Inspire Resort opened a very large indoor art, media and science attraction called Le Space.
- Everland is doing more cooperations with media and IP brands for temporary exhibitions including a Netflix Stranger Things area.

- Paramount Studios announced a partnership with Shinsegae for a major IP Theme Park south of Seoul.

The Outlook for Asia in 2025

The outlook for Asia in 2025 is expected to be mixed once again. The parks in Japan, Korea and Southeast Asia will benefit from recent investments and openings as well as robust tourism. This should give more impetus to local parks to invest in refreshing, renovating and upgrading their contents. Temporary exhibitions and attractions are generally doing well in the region, particularly those with some IP elements. These are expected to continue and expand.

For China, the market will likely remain soft, with low levels of consumer spending.

Lower-cost attractions such as museums, zoos, aquariums and scenic areas will continue to show strong attendance. Alternative format attractions such as digit media art exhibits and indoor

ski /snow play are gaining. Nonetheless, new theme park projects are planned to open in China which will hopefully capture the imagination of the market and investors.
